HYBRID INSTRUCTION PLANNING UPDATE

Thank you to all of the families that have registered for either hybrid instruction or continuation of CDL. At this time, over 90% of our families have registered. We have been working with this data and we can now share some updates with you.

Nestucca Valley Early Learning Center-PREK

Those students registered for hybrid instruction will attend four days a week, Monday–Thursday in the morning hours, and CDL will be offered in the afternoon. Exact times of in-person learning are still to be determined.

Nestucca Valley Elementary- K-6 & Nestucca Junior Senior High-7-12

Students who selected hybrid model will either attend Monday and Tuesday in person or Wednesday and Thursday in person. A typical week would look like:

GROUP A

Monday-attending in person at school
Tuesday-attending in person at school
Wednesday-CDL from home
Thursday-CDL from Home
Friday- Students are off/teacher prep

GROUP B

Monday-CDL from home
Tuesday-CDL from home
Wednesday- attending in person at school
Thursday- attending in person at school
Friday- Students are off /teacher prep

Still TBD- the exact times of instruction and the hours that the buildings will be open to students.

NEXT STEPS-If you have selected the hybrid model for your child, we will be able to communicate if they are part of **GROUP A** or **Group B** by March 10, 2021. The two considerations that will determine whether your child is a part of Group A or B is (1) family size and (2) where you reside in the district

boundaries. These two variable designate how our transportation system will work and in a district this size, that ultimately drives student cohorts.


On March 10, 2021, we will have created the transportation schedule and determined **GROUP A** and **GROUP B** student cohorts. From there, we will then be able to communicate to families the new system that has been created for food service distribution.

If you have yet to register your child, we will be calling you to discuss the steps that need to be taken.

As the first day of hybrid instruction gets closer, we will be offering orientation for families. This orientation will address the daily schedule, the safety precautions, transportation practices and resources for you to access.
