

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS UPDATE MARCH 1, 2021

UPCOMING DATES OF IMPORTANCE:

March 10, 2021-District will communicate Hybrid schedule to each family, transportation times for those choosing to ride the bus, how meal service will work (both in the buildings and at homes) and start/end times for hybrid instruction.

March 15, 2021-NVELC, NVES and NJSR High will be communicating student's schedules and details specific to students transitioning to hybrid and those continuing in CDL.

Will the parent-teacher conferences scheduled for April 15 and April 16 still happen?

No. As we did in the fall, we will schedule individualized appointments as needed. April 15 and 16 will be normal Thursday and Friday schedules.

When my child is Zooming into the classroom, will they be attending from 8:00am-3:00pm?

No. Each building will have varying schedules, but there are structured breaks both in the classroom and at home. As we work through the hybrid model this next quarter, we will be assessing if the new schedule for at home participation is working well or needs to be modified. For more details about a student's daily schedule at school, and at home, please attend our building level town hall meetings during the week of March 15, 2021.

FROM VIRTUAL TOWN HALL MEETING FEBRUARY 17, 2021

Will the hybrid model be two days a week or four?

K-12 will be two days a week in person. The district will be broken up into "A" (Monday and Tuesday) and "B" (Wednesday and Thursday) groups. The days that your student is not in person, they will continue with the CDL model. Fridays will be for teacher planning/prep, meetings and thorough sanitization.

Will the kiddos have any opportunities for a mask "break" throughout the day?

Yes, often.

When will the kids be back to learning in person in the building-full time?

As a school district, we do not get to determine when the kids will be attending in person full time. The Governor's office and Oregon Department of Education, in collaboration with Oregon Health Authority, determines the rules and guidance that school districts must follow in order to offer in person learning for students. As long as school districts have to practice social distancing and designating 35 square feet of space to each person, as mandated by the state, we will be in a hybrid model of instruction. Ultimately, this timeline is driven by the community spread of the COVID 19 virus and the ratio of people in the state who have been vaccinated.

Can we get a sample of what a hybrid day's schedule would look like for the middle school students?

We will post mock schedules to our websites as soon as we have finalized a draft.

For families with siblings, are they going to be in the building on the same days?

Yes.

Can a child bring their own lunch during hybrid?
