Registration for the 2020-2021 school year, for PreK- 12th grade students is now open in the Nestucca Valley School District. Please use this link <https://www.nestucca.k12.or.us/> to find the online registration portal for new and returning students. On this page you will also find a link to registration instructions. It is of great importance to complete this as soon as possible because it will help us determine who needs to borrow a school laptop, which families need help with internet access, and much more. If you have difficulty with internet access at home, we have set up a computer for public use at the JRSR High School. This computer can be accessed Monday through Thursday from 8:00am-3:00pm. If you have further questions please call our school offices at (503) 392-3194 Ext 100, 102 or 301. We realize that this will be the first time that many of our families have registered their child online. Please feel free to reach out with any questions you may have, as this is also new for us, and we are always looking for ways to improve our practices.

A few other dates to keep in mind:

August 31- The district will issue an electronic form, that families can use to sign up for school food service. We will be delivering in the middle of the day, each weekday, with multiple meals for each child, for children who are registered in the NVSD. This is a change from last spring where we fed all kids 1yr olds-18 regardless of if they were NVSD students or not.

September 8-11- The school will be contacting you to schedule a date and time for your family's individual parent teacher conference.

September 8- School food service will begin delivering food to families who register for service.

September 14-18- Each family and student will participate in their virtual parent teacher conference. During the scheduled conference the teacher will meet your child and you, introduce the daily academic schedule and offer instruction on how to use our new online platform CANVAS, ACELLUS and more.
